## TIME AND PLACE:

May 19-21, 2023, Warszawa, Ciechanowiec, IHN PAN

The conference is a planned continuation of the **Medicinal plants in science and culture conference**, the first part of which was held on May 20-22, 2022, at the Staszic Palace, PAN, Warsaw.

Plants and drugs of plant origin are of interest not only to researchers working in the field of natural sciences, but are also a research problem in the arts and social sciences. These research trends rarely meet, confront or complement each other. Efforts to bring experimental sciences, such as phytochemistry and pharmacology, together with historical and social research in the field of herbalism and herbal medicine, were undertaken by Professor Barbara Kuźnicka at the Institute of History of Science, Education and Technology of the Polish Academy of Sciences from the 1980s. The title of the conference refers to these efforts and is addressed to researchers representing cultural anthropology, history of science, history of medicine, history of pharmacy, history of botany and archaeobotany, linguistics, pharmacognosy, pharmaceutical botany, agriculture, forestry and other disciplines.
